Frank West, former Moreno Valley City Councilman and School Board Member, died Monday, November 19, after a short illness. He was 68. Frank was born in Washington D.C. to Richard and Eleanor West and lived in Taiwan, Germany and many states until the family settled in Moreno Valley. He graduated from Moreno Valley High School in 1968 and obtained a BA from UCR. He retired after 30 years as a probation officer with Riverside County. Frank was active in the community, serving as Director of Diamond Girls Softball from 1988 to 1990, board member of the Moreno Valley Unified School District from 1992 to 1996, and member of the Moreno Valley City Council from 1996 to 2008, including terms as Mayor Pro-Tem and Mayor of Moreno Valley. He is survived by wife Karen, daughters Jenifer and husband Butch, Jacqueline and husband Anthony, stepsons Brian and Kevin, 7 grandchildren, sister Ann, brothers Richard and wife Jeannie, Terrance and wife Michelle, and Mark and wife Lisa. He was preceded in death by his brother John. Frank loved sports, especially the Dodgers and Notre Dame. He will be dearly missed by family and friends. Memorial will take place Saturday, Dec 8 at 11AM at Cortner's Chapel in Redlands.
