She was also part of the production staff at WordNet TV for many years. Linda loved travelling for pleasure or to share her faith. Her hobbies included: collecting butterflies and "Faith" signs and symbols, feeding slot machines and reading spiritual books. She joins her parents, Sam and Helen and her brother Tim, who preceded her in death.

Linda will be missed but not forgotten by her husband, Charles, and her children, Kenny and Valerie, and also her siblings, Barbara Whittington, Pat Morgan, Lori Olenick and Cathy Galloway. She will also be missed by her many friends. Everyone will miss her faith and genuine caring nature. For the past 5 years, Linda was a member of St. Thomas Parish and the Riverside Parkinson's support group. She was cared for at Welbrook Assisted Living Facility since October of 2019.
